# Multi-stage research “European Higher education from the perspective of Russian students”

## The research is aimed at:

- defining particular requirements\study processes which may present difficulty to students from Russia;
- pinpointing particular educational needs of Russian students;
- suggesting methods to enable Russian students to gain study and research competencies, which would allow them to successfully study in EU HEIs.
- presenting methodological recommendations which will enable international exchange coordinators and their audiences (interested students and applicants) to improve their preparation to participation in EU study programmes

- Young people, willing to continue their education in the EU.



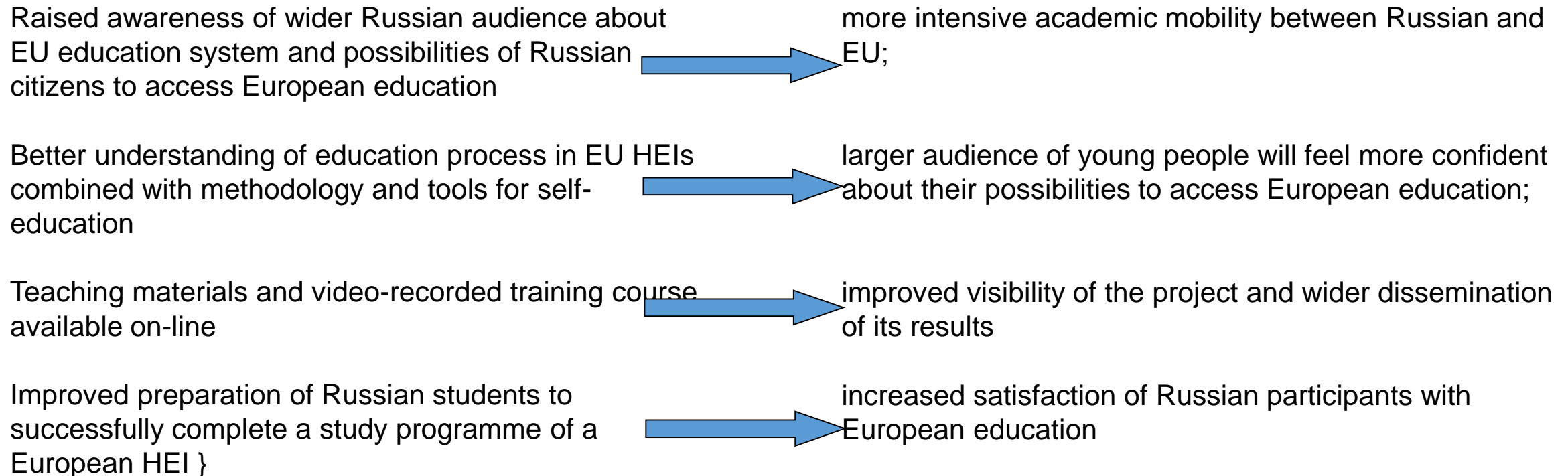

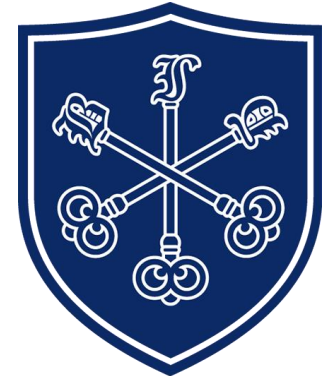
