

Jean Monnet Actions

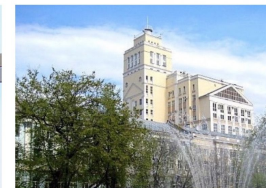

После лекции профессор ответил на все интересующие вопросы. Приглашаются все желающие.

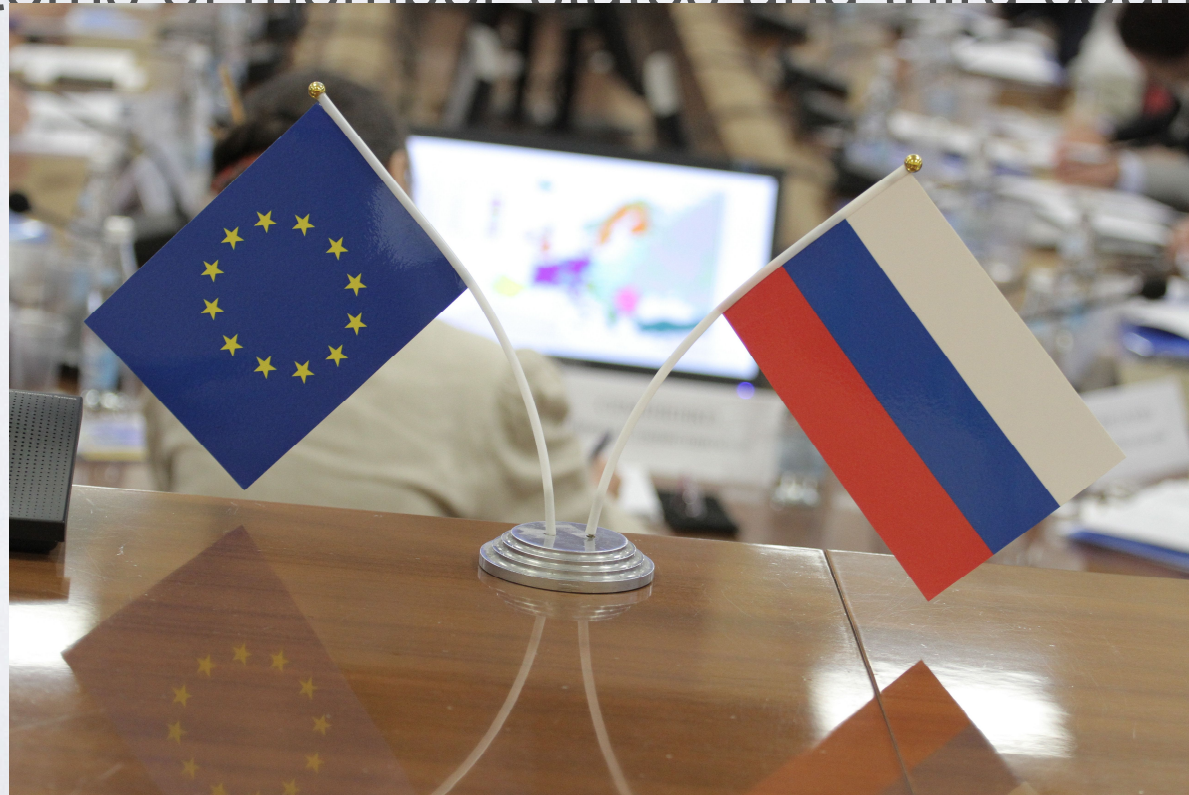
