

- the development of U.-S. energy policy


# primary bias

- disconnect of perception versus reality
- tunnel vision ("focus feature")
- distorted perception ("cockeyed lens")
- overconfidence
- short--term thinking

## ways out - debiasing

- Yetiv's 12 steps:
- For rulers to give up thought that they are different, that they cannot make the same mistakes made by others
- RECOGNITION
- EXCLUDE FEARS
- NO to Cold war era thinking
- NO to World as negative balanced system
- NO to geopolitical approaches
- YES to critical theory
- YES to hesitating





