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# FROM REGIONAL UNIVERSITY TOWARDS INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY



**July 12, 1988 - February 25, 2013** NVSU (former Nizhnevartovsk State University of Humanities - NSUH) functions under the regional department for Education and Youth policy.

**February 25, 2013 – till present** → Federal State Budgetary HEI “Nizhnevartovsk State University” which subordinates to the Ministry of Education and Science RF)

**Shift in priorities** → NVSU recognizes a key role of internationalized education, develops internationalization strategy, prioritizes international activity, which is now focused on the development of scientific and educational collaboration, as well as academic mobility within the scope of international projects.

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## TEMPUS IV (2008-2014)



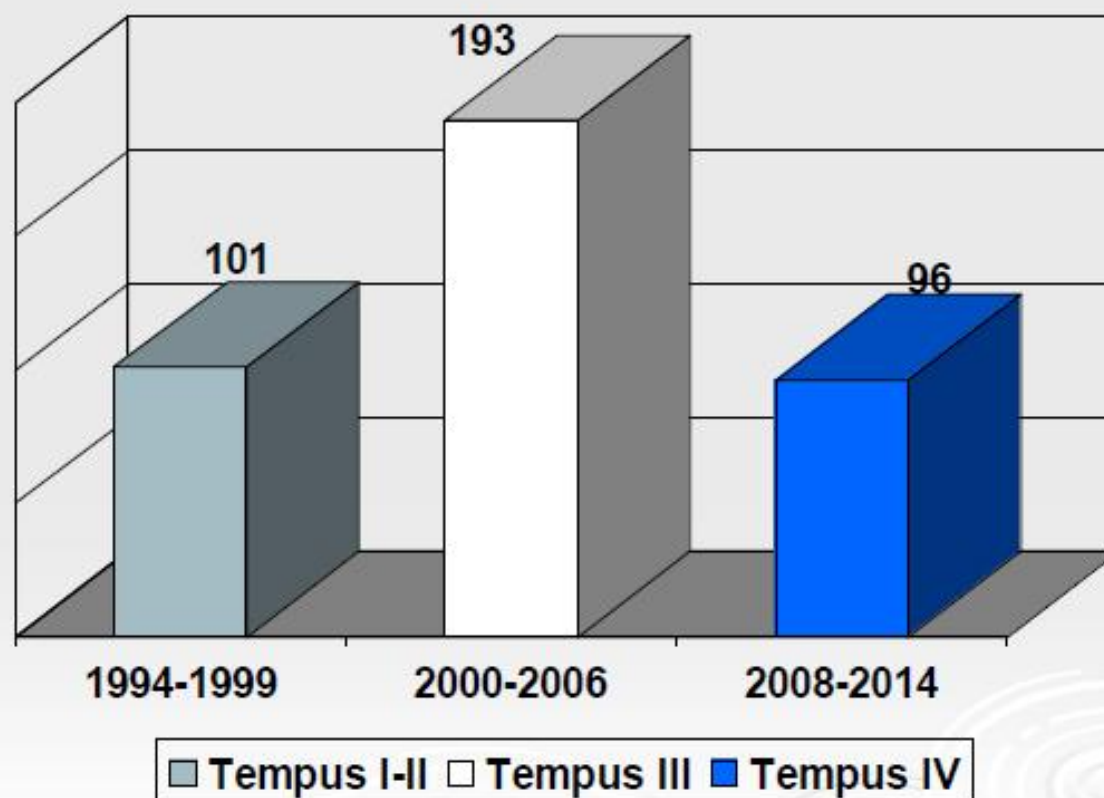

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## Number of projects with Russian participation



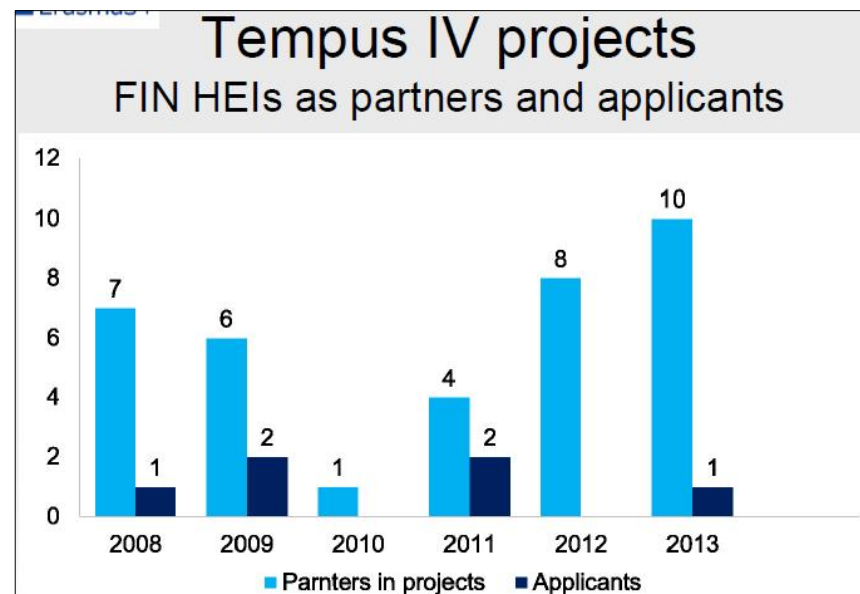

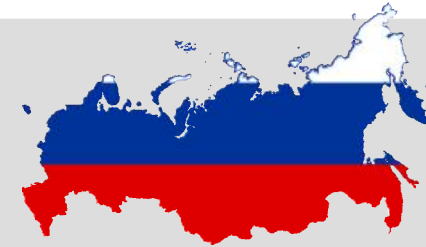

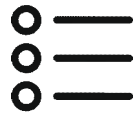


# OBJECTIVES

## Specific Project Objectives:

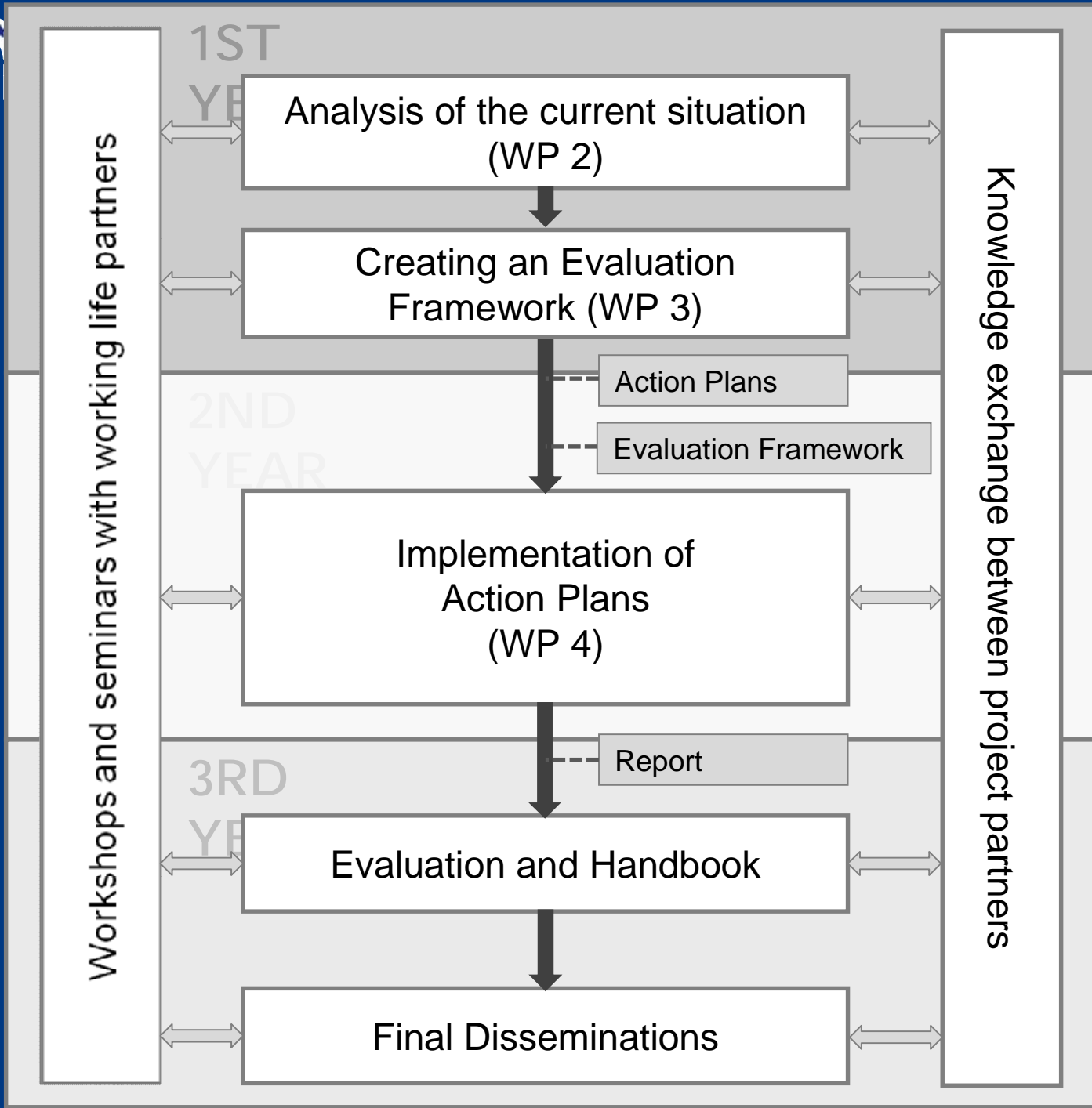
- Assessment of cooperation between HEIs and working-life organizations using general evaluation framework

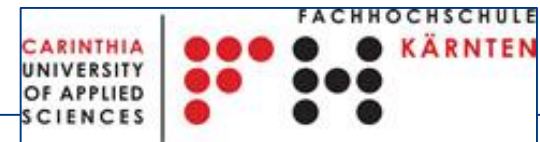
